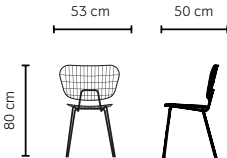

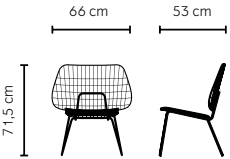
Details

Flip Around by Norm Architects



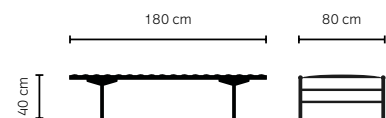

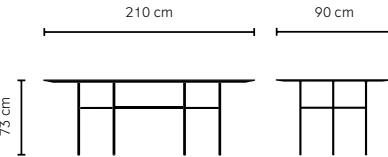

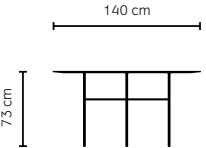

Turning Table by Theresa Arns



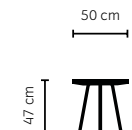
